In the September/October edition of Pain Physician we published the article Occipital Neurostimulation-induced Muscle Spasms: Implications For Lead Placement (Pain Physician 2009; 12:867-876). In post publication discussion we have learned that an error was made in the labeling of the devices in one of the cases. In Case 4, the devices were incorrectly labeled as (Restore Ultra, Medtronic Neurological, Minneapolis, MN) and (Mini Eon, St. Jude Medical, Minneapolis MN). The correct labeling would be (Synergy, Medtronic Neurological, Minneapolis, MN) and (Renew, St. Jude Medical, Minneapolis, MN). The case occurred many years prior to approval of the new devices, and the insertion of

these names were inadvertently incorrect.

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
